In response to Early Years and Key Stage 1 practitioners' need for a more age appropriate approach to the 'FUNS for everyone' programme we have now produced a new 'first FUNS' resource and course.

It includes a book with 12 chapters that provides a mix of creative songs, stories, games and challenges that introduce and reinforce the fundamental movement skills of agility (including locomotion), balance and co-ordination (including object control) that children need to learn to flourish physically in the Early Years and Key Stage 1. The 'first FUNS' package also includes a set of Student Cards, the new FUNS DVD, a sample sticker book and a blue swatch for more able at end of key stage 1.



All the activities have been tried and tested in Early Years and Key Stage 1 settings and schools and two courses have already been delivered in London and Newcastle upon Tyne.

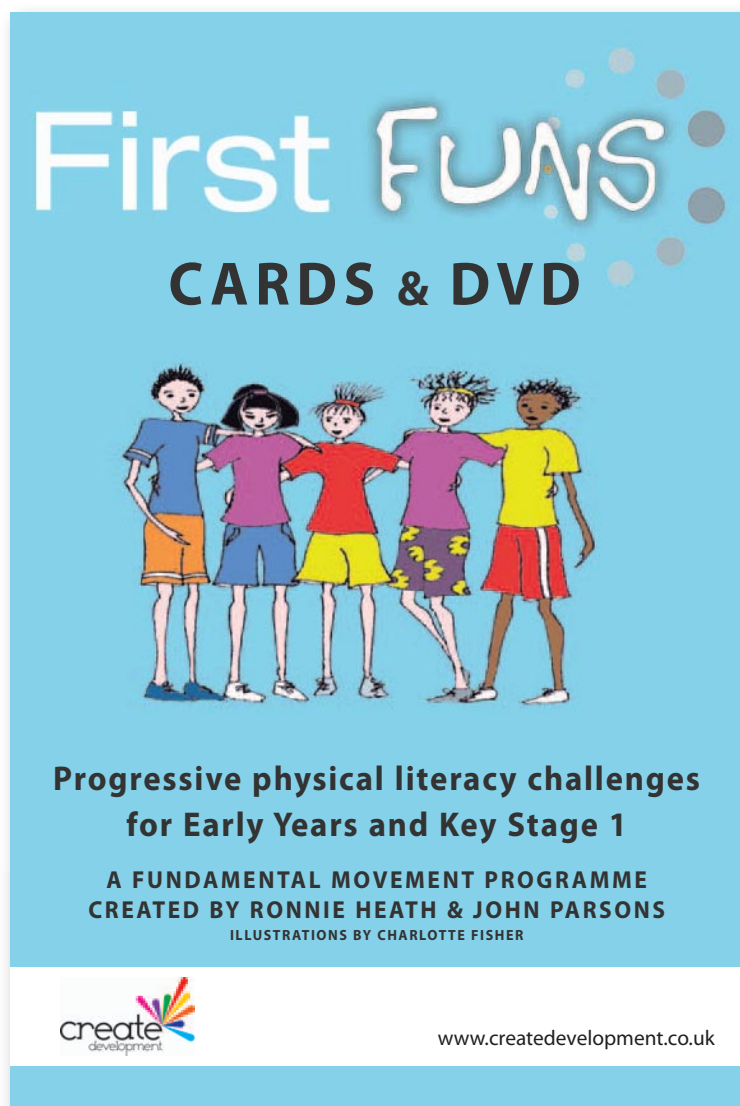

first FUNS game 'popping pirates'

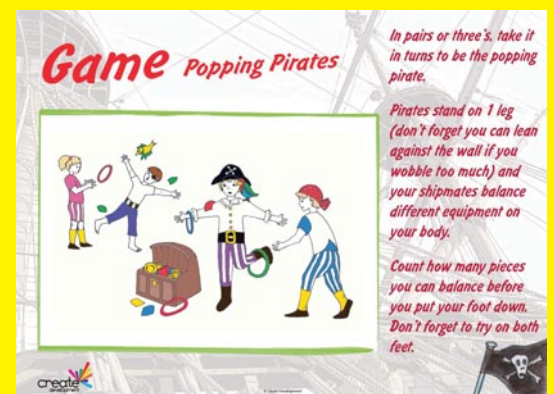
To celebrate the launch of our 'First FUNS' programme and resource, we are giving away a free download of 'Popping Pirates' – one of the 12 games included in the programme.

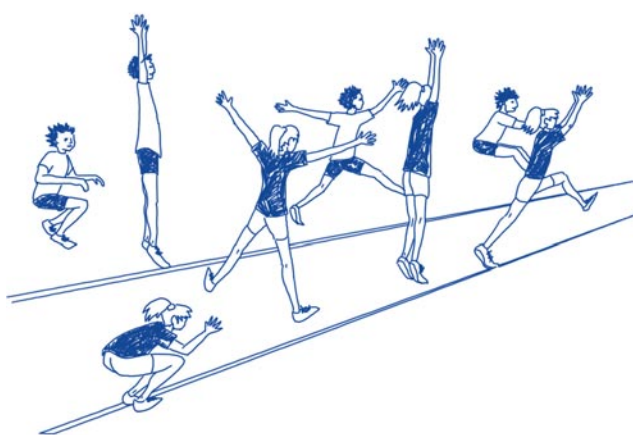
